

Interested in gaining hands on sedimentology and analytical chemistry experience?





The WVU Department of Geology and Geography Environmental Geochemistry lab is hiring a self-motivated and disciplined undergraduate researcher to contribute to a project studying the stratigraphy and chemistry of cave sediments. This ties into the broader goal of a project looking at cave sediments and their potential as a paleoclimate proxy.

Duration: remainder of Fall 2019-March 1st 2020 Broad tasks will include:

- Sediment characterization
- Sediment sample prep (homogenize, dry, weigh, sieve, etc.)
- Organic matter extractions (acid/base dilution, sieving, grinding, centrifuge, etc.)
- Data entry in excel



Preference given to students with prior lab experience or lab coursework and those willing to work over winter break. Students will be expected to work 4-10 hours per week.
